Mini 360 is a pioneering course in Spain, for children between 3 and 5 years old. The main objectives are cognitive and sensory stimulation through games, songs, and exercises designed to awaken and harness the intellectual potential, as well as introducing the child to a holistic learning method, guiding the child towards achieving:

- **1. A positive view of schooling and learning,** and motivation for acquisition of knowledge and personal and social development. Always focusing on positive reinforcement and play as a vehicle for learning.
- **2. Comprehensive training.** This involves the development of intellectual abilities, integration capabilities and social relations, as well as affective and emotional capacities. For this to happen we have experienced professionals with a methodology and set of routines that are based on the combination of Brain & Move and Soroban abacus as driver for the development of children's sequential abilities.
- **3.** Our main goal with the young learners is cognitive stimulation and in particular, exercising the attention mechanisms as the basis of any cognitive process. For this work we resort to the concept of numbers and quantity with abacus and learning through movement with Brain & Move and numerous games to improve attention, memory, coordination, laterality, expressiveness and creativity.
- → BRAIN & MOVE: Bodywork as a warmup that helps us relax, find the natural pace of learning and begin the classes motivated.
- → EMOTIONAL ROLE PLAYING: We seek to enhance the personal growth of our students with the aim of promoting creative thinking and the management of emotions.
- → SPEED WRITING: Practice aimed at the acquisition of skill and speed writing.
- → MANIPULATIVE PRACTICE: Teaching and practicing the manipulation method of the abacus and other instruments and materials for the assimilation of new learning.
- → CALCULATION WITH ABACUS: Automation of the use of the abacus, learning of mathematical rules and practice of operations.
- \rightarrow ANZAN (MENTAL CALCULATION): Visual representation of the abacus, to promote calculating using the imagination.
- → DICTATION: Promotes attention, auditory processing speed and motor agility.
- → FLASH CARDS: Exercises of perception and visual memory.
- → SOCIAL SKILLS AND DEBATE: Initiating the child in the development of active listening, attaining a better communication and reflecting with other students in a creative way.
- → GAMES AND DYNAMICS: Consolidation in a playful and positive way on what it has been practiced during the class (group dynamics and group games).
